

1. Before attending Mass we ask that families take the temperature of each family member to make sure that no one has a fever. One also needs to remain home if one has the following symptoms of cough, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, or at least two of the following symptoms: chills, shaking with chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, and loss of taste or smell.
2. When one arrives please walk single file into church. One family member will tell an usher your name and will mark your family off the list of parishioners attending. You will enter church and tell another usher your name and this usher will walk you to your assigned pew. Each family will have assigned seating and will not be able to sit in one's usual place.
3. For those family members or other parishioners who are not able to attend Mass inside, one can sit in one's car or if the weather is good, on the lawn and watch the Mass by Facebook Live and receive Holy Communion after the final blessing.
4. Social distancing of 6 feet between people not living in the same household must be followed; social distancing is to be practiced at all times and includes seating, processions, communion lines and any lines waiting for admission to the church or exiting.
5. Masks are to be worn by the congregation. **NO MASK. NO ADMISSION** except for children under the age of 2-years-old. Masks are to be worn by ministers at all times when not speaking, reading or singing as part of their ministry.
6. There is no passing of collection baskets or plates. Two boxes will be placed on tables in the narthex for the offerings.
7. There is to be no physical contact during the Lord's Prayer or during the Sign of Peace.
8. Communion is distributed only in the form of Bread and given to communicants only in the hand.
9. The assembly is to be instructed that there will be no vocal words at the distribution of communion, the minister will hold up the sacred host and the communicant will bow.
10. Bathrooms are to be restricted to one occupant at a time.
