**MAY 19 & 20 – DR. FERNANDO CASANOVA IN LEXINGTON**

Doctor Fernando Casanova, one of the most famous Catholic Speakers in the Hispanic world, a former Pentecostal pastor from Puerto Rico who became Catholic together with his wife and children, is coming to our Diocese to give six presentations divided in two different events. **SATURDAY, MAY 19** – Bishop John Stowe will open the day celebrating Mass followed by a bilingual presentation. After, the Anglo audience will proceed to Hehman Hall and Fernando Casanova will have three presentations in Spanish in the church on: his conversion story, the Eucharist and the importance of the Sacrament of Matrimoy. **SUNDAY, MAY 20** – The topics for the second day are the Mother of Jesus and the Dogmas of the Church, his conversion story and preserving the Catholic faith. Both events will have coffee, fresh Mexican pastry and Mexican lunch. The cost is \$20 per day.
